This form is required to be completed by an Eagle candidate <u>prior</u> to initiating his Eagle project. It should be sent to the Scoutmaster and the Eagle Coach.

The purpose of this form is to ensure that the Troop leadership is aware of all project work dates and times and to provide opportunities to minimize overlap or conflict with other Troop activities. Fill in rows for all work days.

Reminders:

- An Eagle project is considered a Troop activity. All rules regarding Troop activities apply to Eagle projects.
- There must always be at least two adults present during all work sessions. One of those adults must be registered with the Troop (ie. Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop Committee) and one must have YPT.
- There should always be available suitable first aid supplies and at least one person with adequate first aid knowledge to provide care for any possible injuries.
- Eagle candidates should be sure to log arrivals and departures of all workers (Scouts, other youths, and adults), to provide safety instruction to all workers. Class "B" uniforms should be encouraged for Troop members.
- Eagle projects are subject to the Troop's COVID-19 rules at the time. Please check if you are unsure what is required.
- Things change! Please try to keep the Scoutmaster informed about changes in work dates.
